5	Islam	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore about three key beliefs of Islam, Tawhid, Risalah, Akhirah. To know the key events of the life of Muhammad Explore diverse groups of Muslims – Sunni, Shi'a, and Sufi. To learn about the Qur'an and worship in Mosques. Explore the Five Pillars – Shahadah, Salah, Zakah, Sawm and Hajj and explain their significance for Muslims. Understand the concepts of greater and lesser Jihad. Learn about key festivals in Islam – Eid-ul-fitr and Eid-ul-Adha 	<p>Summative assessment question</p> <p>Various short multiple choice questions and a longer extended writing piece.
