5	My studies	 Saying what subjects you study and giving opinions about school subjects. Describing your school and its facilities. Using the immediate future to say what you would like to study next year. 	Reading focus 30 minute reading comprehension with multiple choice, comprehension and translation into English.
6	Where you live	 Describing what there is and is not where you live. Using modal verbs to say what you can and can't do where you live. Using the conditional tense to say where you would like to live in the future. 	Writing focus 1 hour writing assessment to produce a leaflet about a city.
